

## Culvert Permit Application

## NOTICE TO APPLICANTS

If 32 feet and under in length, attach a drawing (by hand, not to scale) showing location. If 32 feet or over in length, permit must have stamped engineering drawing showing cleanouts attached. Inspections may be scheduled at <a href="https://www.pooler-ga.gov">www.pooler-ga.gov</a>.

It is essential that all contractors fully comply with the "Call Before You Dig" law by contacting 811 before beginning any digging activities. Additionally, contractors must contact Georgia 811 for a line locate before proceeding with culvert installation.

Before installing any culverts, the contractor must possess a valid utility contractor's license. A city inspector from the Stormwater Department is required to verify the location of utilities on-site before installation can begin. A follow-up inspection is also mandatory before covering the trench to confirm a sealed connection and ensure the use of appropriate bedding materials.

Please note that only reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) is approved for use; plastic or PVC (HDPE) pipe is strictly prohibited. The minimum pipe diameter required by ordinance is fifteen (15) inches, though a larger diameter may be necessary depending on the specific installation area.

Once the culverts are installed, it is the homeowner's responsibility to maintain and repair them, as the city does not assume liability for these tasks.
