Legal Invitation to Bid

POOLER PARKWAY AT BENTON BOULEVARD, MILL CREEK CIRCLE AND I-95 SOUTHBOUND RAMPS

Sealed bids will be received for Pooler Parkway at Benton Boulevard, Mill Creek Circle and I-95 Southbound Ramps Project in the office of the City Clerk at the City of Pooler City Hall, 100 US Highway 80, Pooler, GA, 31322 at 2:00 PM on October 7, 2026, at which time they will be publicly opened and read. A pre-bid conference will be held at Pooler City Hall, Council Chambers, 100 US Highway 80, Pooler, GA 31322 at 2:00 PM on September 16, 2026. Only official plan holders will be allowed to attend the pre-bid conference.

The work will include all equipment, materials, supplies, labor, and all other costs associated with construction of approximately 3,750 linear feet of roadway. The roadway includes the modification of a signalized intersections, sidewalks, drainage improvements, installation and maintenance of erosion, sediment and pollution control BMPs and final site stabilization.

CDR will maintain the official plan holders list. This project is also listed on the Georgia State Procurement Registry.

The City of Pooler reserves the right to waive any informalities, to reject any and all bids, to evaluate bids, to accept portions of any bids and to accept any bid, which in its opinion, may be in the best interest of the City of Pooler and reserves the right to add to or delete from the contract after the contract has been awarded. Bidders must be able to demonstrate a minimum of 5 years of municipal work experience in asphalt paving and drainage improvements in addition to other requirements and be pre-qualified by the Georgia Department of Transportation for the classification of work.

Insurance certificates, meeting those limits as stated in the bid documents, 5% bid bond in the form of a bond submitted by a surety authorized to conduct business in the State of Georgia, or certified or cashier's check and a non-collusion affidavit must be completed and submitted with the bid.
